Subject Area	Art and Design
Subject Aim- Intent	At Chase Terrace Primary School, we have a high-quality Art and Design curriculum which enables our pupils to communicate creatively what they can see, think and feel by using a variety of different mediums and techniques. We aim to engage, inspire and challenge our pupils to use the knowledge and skills they have acquired to experiment, invent and create their own works of art. We encourage this through the study of great artists and their work allowing children to understand how art and design has shaped our history. Cultural and local experiences enable children to reflect on the value of our nation's creativity and diversity. This gives our children the skills they need to effectively express themselves through the form of art and design.
Subject Approach	Investigative skills from the National Curriculum set against subjects provide the knowledge and conceptual understanding children need to succeed in life.
	Subjects are taught on a termly or half-termly basis dependent on the demands of the curriculum.
	• For each subject, lessons are taught as blocks over a week period.
	 Our lessons are planned to frequently embed the Art and Design objectives within a range of different contexts to give children opportunities to create, explore and record their ideas; develop different techniques and mediums; understand and use appropriate artistic language; discover a range of great artists and their artwork; experience, evaluate and produce a variety of cultural artwork and explore our local area through different mediums and techniques.
