

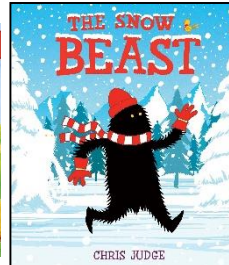
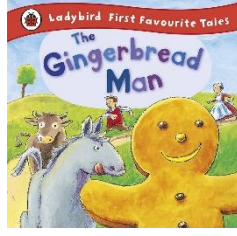
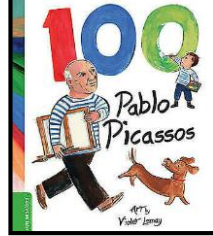
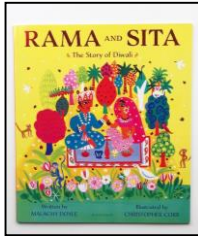
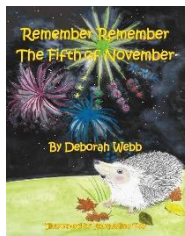
# Reception Autumn 2

They will be learning the importance of sharing and talking about things they are good at.</p>	<p><b>Physical Development (PE)</b></p> <p>Children will practice aiming with control when rolling, throwing and catching a ball.</p>	<p><b>Understanding the World (Computing)</b></p> <p>Children will be exploring simple programmes on the computers. We will look at the story of Rama and Sita and explore rangoli patterns, diva lamps and mehndi.</p>
