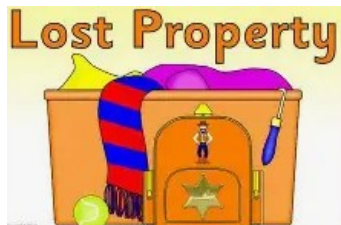

To help track attendance, we use a Traffic Light system. This is used to identify children whose attendance falls below target.

10 days off school each year	95%	Slightly concerned
20 days off school each year	90%	Concerned
30 days off school each year	85%	Very concerned
