Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to inform you that the 14th November is Children in Need Day and we would like your help to raise some money to support the charity. To raise money, we will be holding a non-uniform day. Children can wear Pudsey accessories or Pudsey themed clothing if they wish. Please bring in a donation to support this valuable cause.

Additionally, we are setting a challenge for children to complete if they would like to. This year's theme is: 'Challenge Yourself to 25.' On Friday 7th November, every child will be given a record card. This contains 25 boxes to fill with acts of kindness. We have been looking at kindness in assemblies and in PSHE. The challenge is for each child to complete 25 acts of kindness by Friday 14th November. These can be at home or in the community, for example, holding a door open for someone or tidying up at home. Once an act of kindness has been completed, it should be noted down in one of the boxes (you will need to keep it brief!) and signed by an adult. Once all 25 boxes are filled, the form can be handed to the class teacher and it will be entered into a prize draw. Each entry will cost 50p. A child in each phase will win a prize. The deadline for entries is 12 o'clock midday on Friday 14th November.
