Punctuality Reminder

We are still seeing a significant number of children arriving late to school, and we kindly ask for your support in helping your child arrive on time each day.

Arriving late can have a real impact on children. They may miss the important calm start to the morning, including registration, settling in activities, and key instructions for the day. This can leave them feeling unsettled, embarrassed, or unsure of what they need to do making it harder for them to focus and learn.

A prompt start helps children feel confident organised, and ready for a successful day of learning. It also ensures the class can begin lessons smoothly without disruption.

Attendance 'Traffic Light' System

To help track attendance, we use a Traffic Light system. This is used to identify children whose attendance falls below target.

The children took part with great enthusiasm and were fully engaged. They enjoyed trying out the equipment and having fun whilst learning important skills.



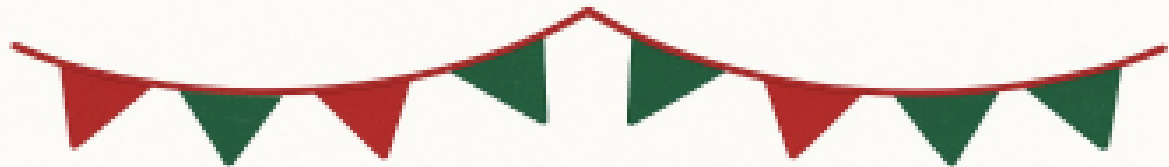
CHOIR
