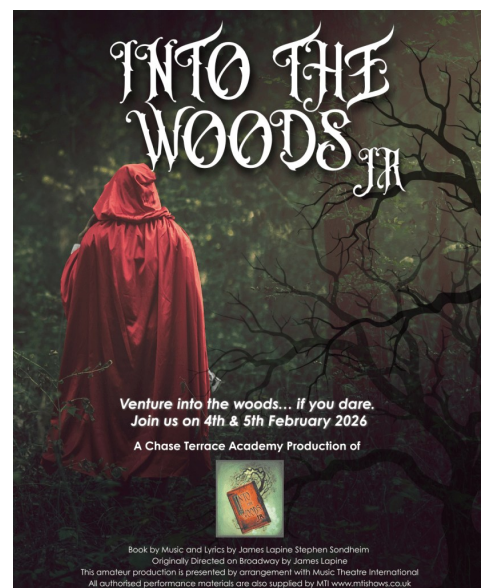
## Erasmus Darwin Football Competition
