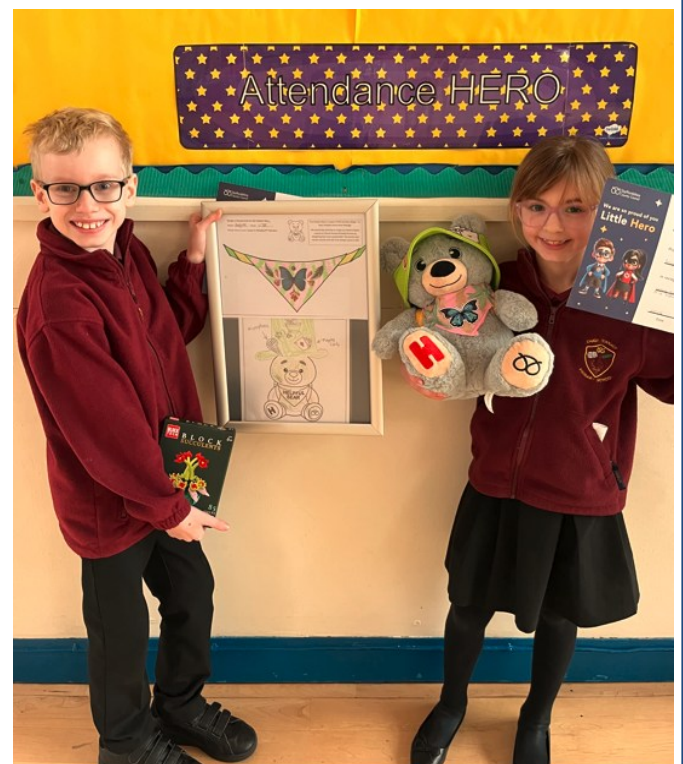
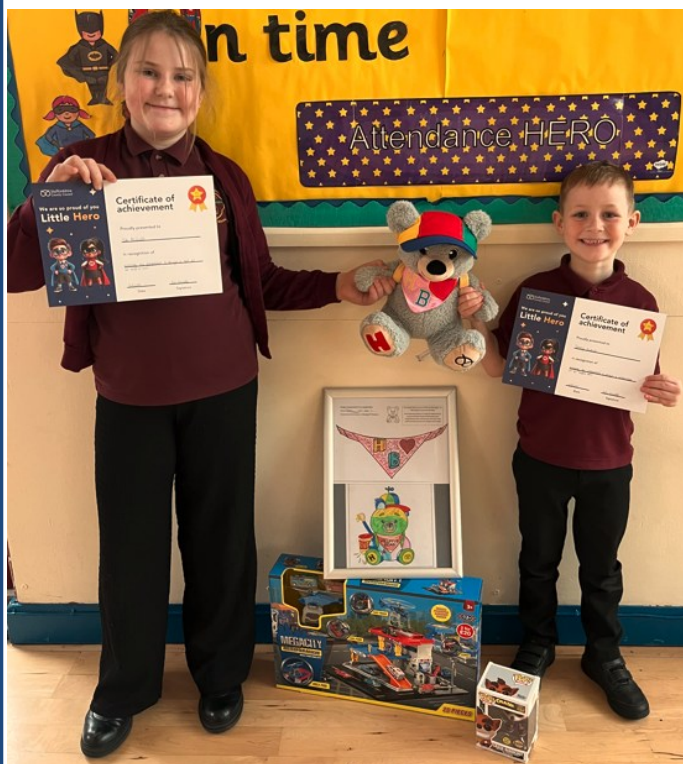
I am delighted to share some photos from our recent whole-school competition.

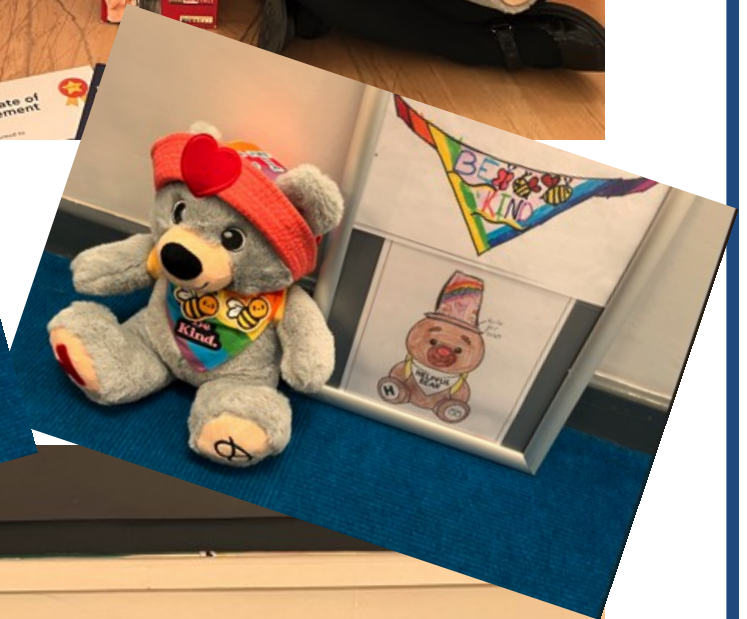
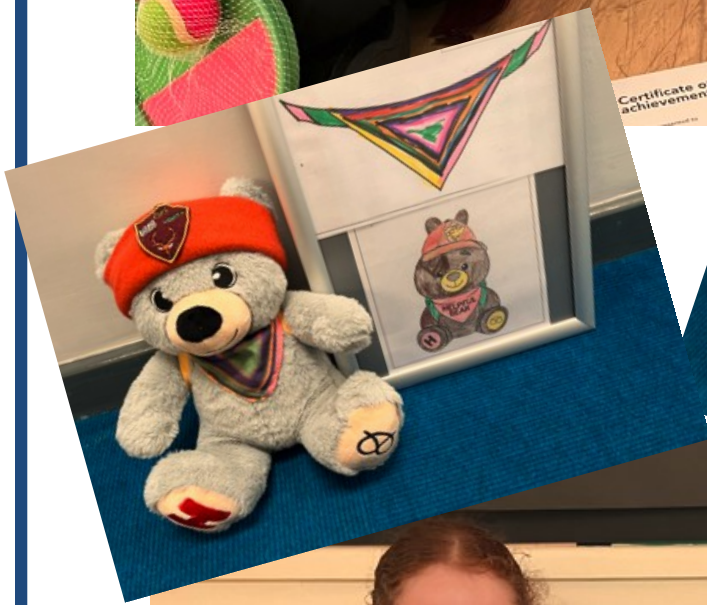
Congratulations to our winners, who not only received a prize but also had the exciting opportunity to see their designs brought to life!
