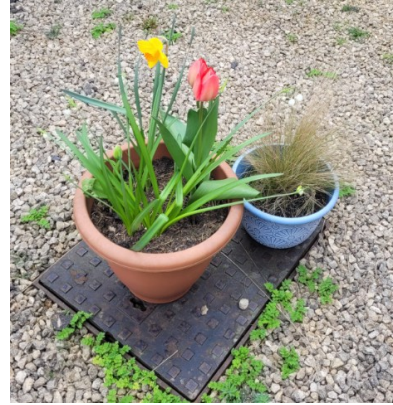

### Year 5 Trip to Burntwood Fire station

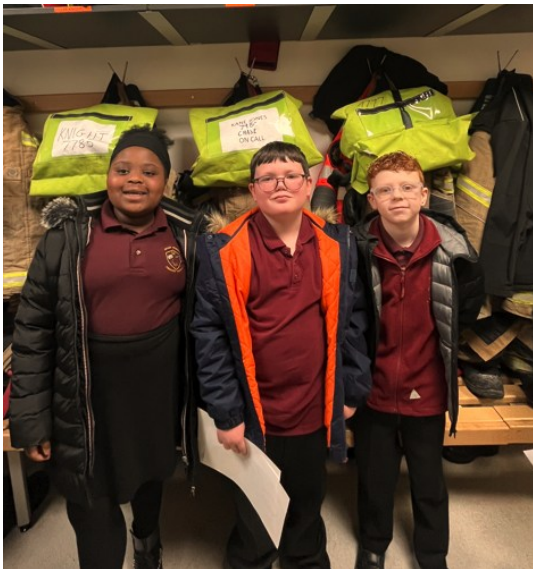
Our Year 5 children had an exciting and informative visit to Burntwood Fire Station, where they learned all about staying safe in different situations.

Throughout the visit they took part in a range of talks delivered by professionals covering, fire safety, National railway safety, water safety, police safety and bank safety.

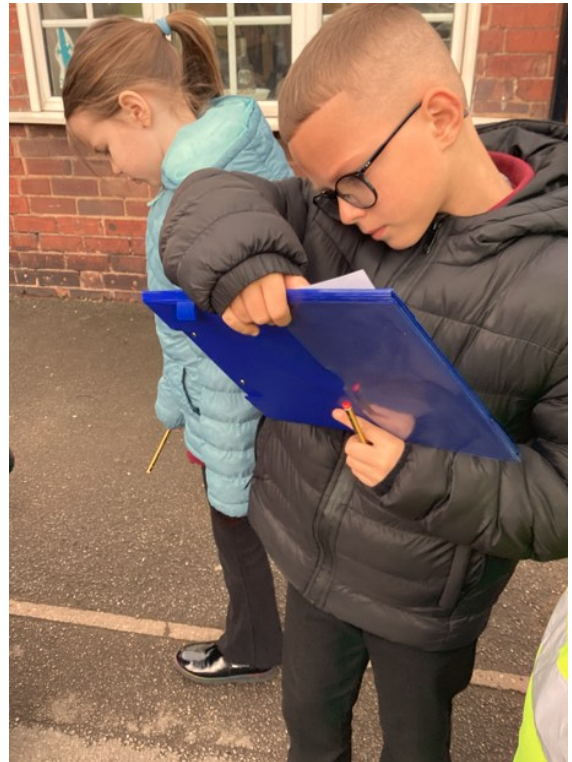
The children even experienced a real call out at the station, which made the visit even more memorable!

This hands-on experience supported their learning in the classroom, helping them to develop their map-making skills and deepen their understanding of the local environment.

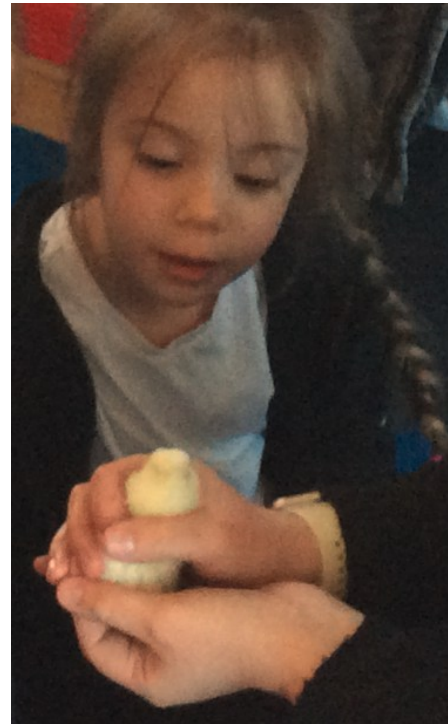
The pupils showed great curiosity, asked thoughtful questions, and represented the school brilliantly throughout the visit.
