TO SCHOOL LUNCHES AND MILK ORDERS

The way we order school lunches and milk is **changing!**

STARTING FROM 1st JUNE

From 1st June, lunches and milk will need to be ordered **in advance** via ParentPay.

ALL CHILDREN including those in receipt of Free School Meals and Universal Infant Free School Meals **need to order in advance.**

The school menu will be on ParentPay for children and parents/carers to decide what they would like to order.

You can order **a day at a time** or **a week in advance.**
