Exciting Refurbishment Project Begins

We are delighted to announce that we have secured funding to refurbish the Girls' KS1/ LKS2 toilets. This important project will provide improved facilities for our pupils, creating a more comfortable, modern and welcoming environment.

You can order **a day at a time** or **a week in advance.**

Cut off for ordering is **MIDNIGHT EACH DAY** for the following day.

Children will be **UNABLE TO ORDER** at the school office or in class.
